SAFETY ADVICE

When re-fuelling, it is advisable to:

1. Take care when stopping watch for oil and spilled fuel on the forecourt
2. Switch your ignition off
3. Get off of the bike
4. Refuel with the bike on the side stand
5. Unless you want to chance having your expensive chrome tank inlet frame dented rather refill yourself
6. Take care and do not overfill, some caps leak and it is dangerous having fuel flow out of your tank onto your bike and onto your clothing.
7. If you do happen to spill fuel over your tank do not wipe with the abrasive paper towel the attendant will provide you with, but rather a soft cloth or wet wipe, fuel spills left on especially matt finish paint jobs will result in ugly marks.
8. Make sure nobody is smoking near your bike
9. Take note of where the nearest fire extinguisher is.
10. When on outrides to small towns carry enough cash for fuel refills, garage card machines might decide to take a holiday!
11. Always a good thing to calculate the range of your tank, this will ofcause depend on speed, wind, pillion and luggage.

My Dad kept staring at her. The teenager kept looking and would find my Dad staring every time.

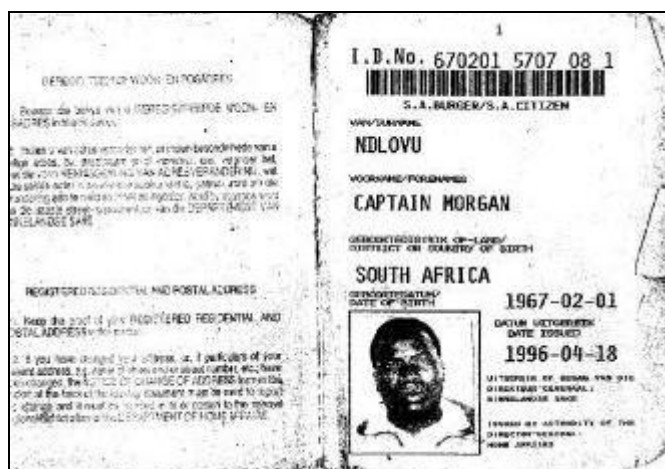
When the teenager had had enough, she sarcastically asked: "**What's the matter old man, never done anything wild in your life?**"
