### SAFETY ADVICE

**Scenario: Water flowing over the road in front of you...**

It is advisable to:

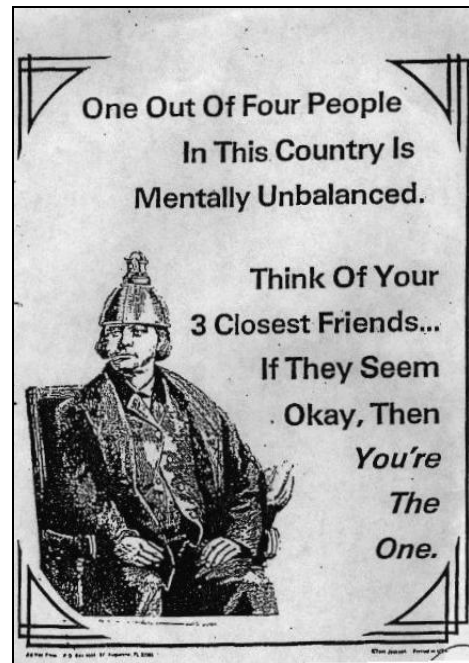
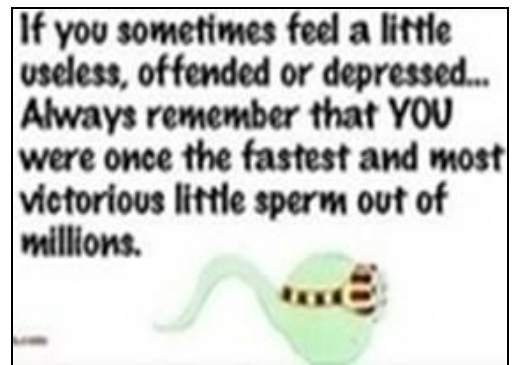
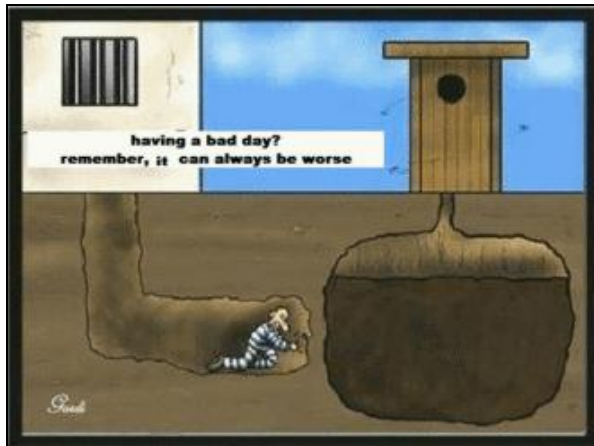
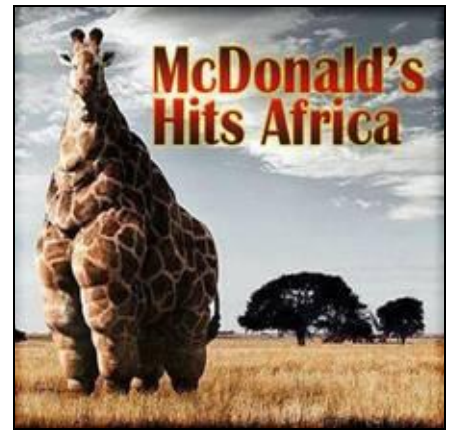
1. Not change gears while in the water;
2. Not brake;
3. Pull in your clutch - you want to pass through the water as smoothly as possible;
4. Make no radical turning action;
5. If on a turn enter and exit with the most direct line as possible, with that I mean with the bike as upright as possible;
6. On exit feather your breaks to clear water on your brake pads and discs;
7. Brief your pillion not to move around while you are negotiating the hazard;
8. Stay alert with bikes in front of you should you have to take evasive action;
9. Stay cautious as the water could conceal a pothole;
10. Stay alert for water spray that will most likely be caused by oncoming vehicles.
